Supply List 2017 – 2018

PRESCHOOL

Box of 16 regular-size crayons - 4 yr. old class
Box of 8 large size crayons - 3 yr. old class
Plastic art box for flashcards
Book bag (that can hang on hallway hook)
Gym shoes - Note: If your child regularly wears gym shoes or soft-soled shoes, gym shoes to keep at school aren't needed
Box of 5 oz. Dixie Paper Cups
3 refill bags of baby wipes

Last names Q-Z bring package of napkins

SIXTH GRADE

2 Spiral Notebooks (One notebook to be RED minimum 100 pages (one is for Journal in Mrs. Belt's LA class, one for Mrs. Aldrich's class)
2 pocket folders (plus folders for Mrs. Belt – see below)
1 Zippered Binder or Trapper Keeper
3 boxes of Kleenex
3 rolls of paper towels
Crayons or colored pencils
Ruler with centimeters and inches
1 package (500 sheets) white printer paper for computer lab
Glue & Scissors
White Out Tape ONLY
The NEW AMERICAN Bible (see Grades 5-8 note)

1 spiral notebook 120 pages for Social Studies and Religion
1 package (500 sheets) white printer paper for computer lab
2 packages white note cards 3 x 5 (lined or blank)
3 boxes Kleenex (more for those with allergies)
2 containers of antibacterial wipes
See Art class, P.E. class, and assignment notebook notes.
The NEW AMERICAN Bible - (See Grade 5-8 note)
NO white out in Math Class
NO binders or Trapper Keepers that will **not** fit in desks

P.E. CLASS

Gym shoes - must be left in locker (ALL GRADES)
Kindergarten & 1st grade - velcro gym shoes
Gym socks (to be left in locker or gym bag)
Grades 4 - 8 will need an I.C.S. P.E. uniform (shorts and t-shirt). This may be purchased at Athletic Outfitters or LogoWorks. During colder weather plain grey sweatpants may be worn. ALL ITEMS MUST BE LABELED WITH NAME, on the tag or front of garment ONLY. Students should keep P.E. clothes in a separate gym bag.

ART CLASS 1ST – 8TH GRADE

These supplies are in addition to classroom supplies:

ASSIGNMENT NOTEBOOKS

GRADES 2 - 8

All students in grades 2- 8 will need to purchase an assignment notebook FROM THE SCHOOL at the beginning of the school year. Cost - \$4

Grades 5 - 8: PLEASE NOTE:

* Students in Grades 5 - 8 need a copy of the New American Bible. THIS IS THE ONLY VERSION TO BE USED, and may be purchased in the Religious Education Office in the fall.
* Binders or trapper keepers must fit in desks.
* NO white out in Math class for grades 5 – 8
Combination locks are no longer needed.

ALL GRADES: Books must be covered with book covers. If using the stretch book covers, they must be the **X-LARGE** or **JUMBO** size - the smaller sizes break the bindings.

All bookbags must fit into lockers. Avoid large, wheeled bookbags.
